Age-Friendly Louisville (AFL) is a city-wide initiative led in partnership by Louisville Metro Government, AARP Kentucky, KIPDA, and the UofL Trager Institute. AFL's mission is clear: to cultivate an inclusive city where individuals of all ages and abilities can thrive, welcoming and supporting individuals at every stage of life, from the youngest members of our communities in strollers to the eldest who may rely on walkers for mobility. Recognizing the universal nature of aging, AFL believes that creating an agefriendly environment benefits society as a whole.

AFL's efforts encompass various aspects of community life, from infrastructure to social connections. Through "drive-by" holiday parades during COVID and various resource guides, AFL demonstrated its commitment to fostering inclusivity and community engagement. Other endeavors resulted in policy changes like the approval of accessory dwelling units by the Louisville Metro Council. Through collaborative efforts and



comprehensive planning, AFL has successfully completed its initial five-year plan and is now gearing up for its 2024-2027 Strategic Plan. This new plan focuses on three key domains: Housing, Social Inclusion, and Outdoor Enhancement.
